3. Procedure

3.1 Providing there is space available, transfer students may enroll in the MTECH Cosmetology, Master Hair Design and Master Barber, and Nail Technician program and receive credit for prior instructional hours earned at another State of Utah Technical College. All courses completed at another institution will be counted toward program completion.

Admission steps for external transfer students from a State of Utah Technical College:

- 3.1.1 Students must complete the application and testing required for admission.
- 3.1.2 Students must provide Student Services an official transcript and service count documentation from the previous institution.

- 3.1.3 Once transcripts and service counts are reviewed, student services will notify student of the credit transferred.
- 3.1.4 Student Services will notify all students, who have requested information for a specific course, of any open space that may become available, through email.
- 3.1.5 Student registration will be given to the first person to contact Student Services, register and pay all course tuition and fees.
